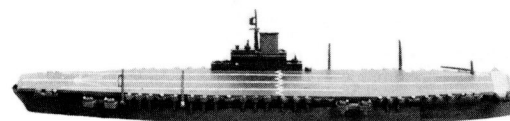


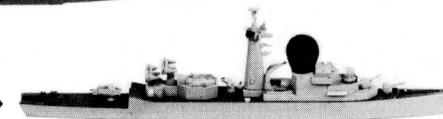

SHINANO – Japanese Aircraft Carrier. Originally laid down as a YAMATO class battleship, this 64,800 ton giant was converted to an aircraft carrier after the Battle of Midway. Like TAIHO, she was fitted with an armored deck. The Japanese planned to use her to repair and maintain aircraft from other carriers. However, she never lived to fulfill this mission as the American submarine ARCHERFISH sunk her on her maiden voyage just seven weeks after her commissioning. Trident has done an excellent job on this 1:1250 scale metal model. The flight deck is beautifully marked as the above picture will attest. A fine showpiece for any collection. Order No. T-1050.

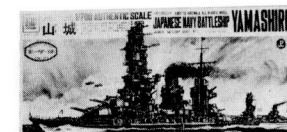
SUFFERN – French Guided Missile Destroyer. This sleek vessel of the modern French Navy displaces 6000 tons and is armed with two Mascara anti-aircraft missile launchers, two 3.9 inch and two 30mm AA guns along with four ASW torpedo tubes. She can attain a speed of 34 knots and is designed to provide the best possible resistance to an atomic blast. Sister ship: DEQUESNE. Order No. T-37.

Each comes with a motor (batteries not included) that drives the propeller shaft. English instructions are provided.
