

NEW MODELER'S POWER TOOL

For the collector who really likes to refine his 1:1200 metal ship models or who likes to do conversion work (i.e., converting a model to a similar class which is not now available, for an example, see our catalog), ALNAVCO now has available a power tool made especially for hobbyists.

The new Badger Electric Bench Top Power Tool will cut, grind, buff, polish, rout, deburr and drill both plastic and metal. It runs at 3000 rpm and has a 1/60th, 60 cycle, 120 volt A.C. shaded pole motor in a high-impact, high-heat styrene motor housing. It has a two foot long flexible shaft, hand piece and a 3/32" standard collet and comes with a \$5.00 assortment of accessories. This tool should make life a lot easier for all you ship model converters!
